[PROPOSED] ORDER APPROVING
(1) ATTORNEYS' FEES AND EXPENSES;
AND (2) SERVICE AWARDS

This Court, having considered Plaintiffs' motion for (1) Award of Attorneys' Fees and Expenses; and (2) Service Awards, having held a fairness hearing on February 27, 2023, having considered all of the submissions and arguments with respect to the motion, and having ruled on the motion, ORDERS as follows:

1. The Court awards to Class Counsel reasonable and appropriate attorneys' fees in the amount of \$7 million, which is 28% of the Settlement Fund.

2. Class Counsel, Robbins Geller Rudman and Dowd LLP, shall allocate the attorneys' fee award among additional moving Class Counsel based on its reasonable assessment of the relative contributions of such counsel to the prosecution of the Action on behalf of the Class.

3. The Court awards to Plaintiffs' Counsel reasonable expenses in the amount of \$2,288,388.90, which were necessarily incurred in the prosecution of this Action.

4. The Court awards Service Awards in the amounts of \$15,000 and \$15,600 to Plaintiffs National Employees Health Plan and Local 295 IBT Employer Group Welfare Fund, respectively.

5. Without affecting the finality of this Order in any respect, this Court reserves jurisdiction over any matters related to or ancillary to this Order.

6. Finding that there is no just reason for delay, this Order shall constitute a final judgment pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. The Clerk of the Court is directed to enter this Order on the docket.
